

This versatile material can be recycled many times, not only giving huge savings in energy and to the world's resources, but VEKA Recycling has one difference that few others can claim. Its purpose-built recycling plant at Behringen in

Germany, backed by its UK-based primary separation facility, actually recycles to such purity, that it can be made into new windows, not just secondary products like drain or sewage pipes. In fact, the VEKA system can not only turn old windows into 15,000 tonnes of clean recycled PVC-U a year, it can also separate for re-used glass, steel and gasket materials.

Double glazing is available on all our products, but it's worth pointing out that triple glazing can further reduce heat loss through the window compared to double glazing, making it a more efficient product.






